Over 25% of our campers are faithless, 30% are fatherless, 40% are churchless, and 80% are under-resourced. Will you join us in our mission by serving for a week this summer?

**Gather a small group (up to 8) for a week-long multi-generational missions experience!** As part of our Summer Mission Opportunity (SMO) Program, high school students (14+) and adults integrate into Camp for one week - serving where most needed, worshiping in the chapel, and participating in meals and activities! It will be the best week of your summer!

Teenagers must be accompanied by an adult chaperone (parent, church member, mentor) in order to participate in the program. While the adult chaperones volunteer in a variety of capacities, high school volunteers participate in our Leader in Training (LIT) program, serving alongside other teenage volunteers while participating in games and devotions.

## Minors

**All applicants under 18yo must email their completed application to [dway@beechpoint.com](mailto:dway@beechpoint.com).** The application includes general information, get-to-know-you questions, essays, and information about how to complete health forms.

## Adults

**All applicants, 18+ yo, must submit their application online:**

- Please visit [beechpoint.org/serve](https://beechpoint.org/serve) and click on "New Volunteer Application" or "Returning Volunteer Application"
- Complete each step of the application. Below, are a few items to consider:
- **Step 2: Basic Info** : please select "New Volunteer: 2023" or "Returning Volunteer: Summer." Do not select any other options. The other options are for paid staff and will significantly lengthen the application.
- **3 Required References** : Even if you are a returning volunteer, it is necessary to input three references each year. You may include references you have listed in the past. This is required by the State of Michigan.
- **Forms** : Complete all forms, located in the left column of the application page. Forms need to be completed in order for us to run background checks.
